**Festival Information:**

The festival is intended to foster a lifelong love of singing for young men with changing and changed voices, from grades 8-12, and to provide an opportunity to experience singing with a collegiate men's choir.

The Pennsylvania State University Glee Club, a sixty-voice men's choir, comprises students from all colleges across the University Park campus. Recent highlights include performing at the Lincoln Center in January 2018, touring Iceland in 2016, and appearing at the 2014 ACDA Eastern Division conference. The Hi-Lo's are a select group of 10 singers drawn from the membership of the Glee Club, known for their entertaining and energized performances.

**Schedule:**

In the morning session, participants will join forces with the Hi-Lo's to learn two pieces, and after lunch, rehearse three more pieces with the Pennsylvania State University Glee Club. The day concludes with an informal public performance for which admission is free. If a director is bringing an intact men's choir, that choir may also perform on the final concert.

A member of the Penn State voice faculty will be available to offer individual, 15-minute voice lessons (at no cost) in the morning. These lessons are intended for Seniors and Juniors who are seriously considering studying voice at college. Lesson spots will be filled in the order that applications are received, and will initially be limited to one student from each school.



Accompanying teachers or chaperones are responsible for the supervision of students at all times.

### **University Rules:**

Students are expected to stay in the designated spaces on campus at all times.

- The possession or use of alcohol and other drugs, fireworks, guns and other weapons is prohibited.
- The operation of a motor vehicle by minors is prohibited while attending and participating in the program.

- Hazing of any kind is prohibited. Bullying including verbal, physical, and cyber bullying are prohibited.
- No theft of property regardless of owner will be tolerated.
- No use of tobacco products (smoking is prohibited in all University buildings) will be tolerated.
- Misuse or damage of University property is prohibited. Charges will be assessed against those participants who are responsible for damage or misusing University property.
- The inappropriate use of cameras, imaging, and digital devices is prohibited including use of such devices in showers, restrooms, or other areas where privacy is expected by participants.
